- **Peta-Louise Bagott** – Rising Star at Carmelite Chambers currently instructed to appear in the United Nations International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals in the Ratko Mladić appeal proceedings and together with Felicity leading a team of international scholars, granted leave to file submissions as Amicus Curiae in the IRMCT Appeals Chamber in the Radovan Karadžić appeal.
